

North Nodaway Memorial Scholarship Awards Application Form

Purpose

The purpose of the North Nodaway Memorial Scholarship Foundation (NNMSF) Awards is to provide college scholarship awards to any student students (not based on GPA) who have shown a career interest in continuing their education in a vocational school, college, or university, or another post-secondary institution.

Awards

For the academic year 2017 - 2018, one undergraduate scholarship award is available in the amount of \$1000 Awards and are for one year only. All scholarship awards will be paid **directly to the school** and may be applied however the student and/or school as deemed necessary by the executive board of the fund.

Eligibility

1. Applicants must be full-time undergraduate students attending a vocational/technical college, or any other university or college.
2. Applicants must include a statement of financial need and proof of students' financial statement on college/school letterhead. This may be on a separate page in the form of a letter, proof of income, or in a short essay, along with disclosure of other scholarship awards.
3. Provide a copy of letter of admission to the school chosen
4. Two (2) letters of recommendation from current teacher(s) and reference outside of school concerning progress in current classes or subjects and applicants character within the community.
5. A statement from the applicant's current principal attesting to the applicant's character
6. Applicants must be US citizens.

The North Nodaway Memorial Scholarship Awards are awarded without regard to race, sex, religion, age, national origin or sexual orientation. The NNMSF will not award scholarships to applicants who are not qualified and reserves the right not to award a scholarship in a given year.

Selection Criteria

1. Demonstrated or expressed interest in continuing their education to develop skills that will assist them in obtaining gainful employment upon graduation from the program chosen.
2. Student essay: A minimum 500 word essay on subjects pertaining to making ethical and moral decisions with examples (ie; the decision making process used to determine whether or not to drink and drive
3. Letters of recommendation

Application Requirements

To be considered for a NNM Scholarship Award, applicants must complete an application and return it to the North Nodaway Mustang Memorial Foundation with a post-mark of no later than May 1st. The application must include:

1. A completed application form. ***Only completed application forms will be considered.***
2. Three letters of recommendation from a teacher or school official
3. A statement from the applicant's current principal attesting to the applicant's character
4. A one to two page (500 word minimum) statement stating the applicant's qualifications and educational and career goals. Students are STRONGLY encouraged to also discuss within the body of the paper, including the processes or thoughts that go into making moral or ethical decisions, as to whether or not to drink and drive. Original ideas and thoughtful insight to this question will weigh heavily on the application process.

Letters of recommendation should be sent as pdf files (with the name of the applicant as part of the file name) directly from the author to nnmustangsmemorial@outlook.com. Alternatively, letters can be mailed to the Scholarship Program at the mailing address above. The letter should indicate the capacity in which the letter writer knows the applicant, e.g. as a student, employee, or other capacity.
